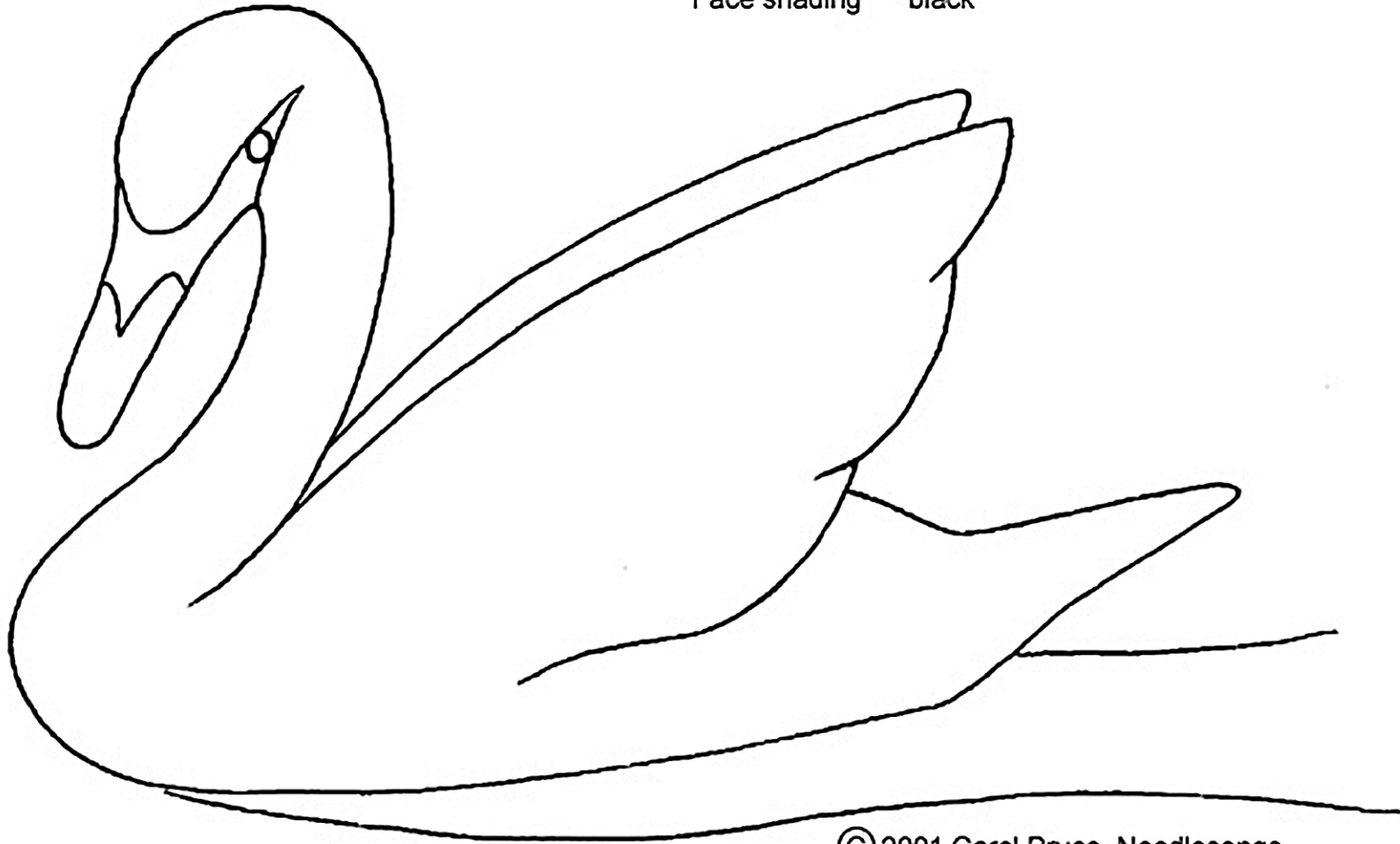


Gliding Swan

Here's a graceful swan to glide across your quilt with only 4 pieces to cut and fuse.

For a realistic swan, use these colors:

Body	white
Far wing	gray
Beak	orange
Face shading	black



Gliding Swan

Cut out swan in the colors indicated. If desired, add a layer of lightweight white fusible interfacing beneath the white fabric.

Follow your regular fusible applique routine—but if you're new at it or would like more instructions, click on [Needlesongs Basic Directions](#) page.

Satin stitch all edges and detail lines.

Add the swan's eye with embroidery or a black button.

Shaded areas on the pattern go beneath adjacent pieces.
